IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF TEXAS

To all to whom these presents shall come, know ye

I, C. A. Culberson, GOVERNOR of the STATE aforesaid, by virtue of the power vested in me by LAW and in accordance with the LAWS of SAID STATE in such case made and provided do by these presents GRANT to M. J. Thurman, her heirs or assigns FOREVER, One Hundred and Sixty (160) Acres of LAND, situated and described as follows.

In Floyd County, being Sur. N. 6, Block L. D. 2, on the waters of White River, a tributary of the Brazos River, about 11 1/2 miles N. 3/4 W. from Floydada. By virtue of an affidavit made before the Clerk of the County Court of Floyd County May 19th 1894, under an act for the benefit of actual occupants of Public Lands Approved May 26th 1873.

Beginning at an Earth M^{ts} and 4 pits, made for the N.W. cor. of M. S. Thurman's Sec. 4, T. 6, S. 4, E. 1, this sur. Thence West 950 rs. to an Earth M^{ts} and 4 pits, for N.W. cor. Thence South 950 rs. to an Earth M^{ts} and 4 pits for S.W. cor. Thence East 950 rs. to an Earth M^{ts} and 4 pits, for the S.W. cor. of said M. S. Thurman's Sec. 4, T. 6, S. 4, E. 1, of this sur. Thence North 950 rs. along the West line of M. S. Thurman's sur. to the place of beginning.

Hereby relinquishing to her the said M. J. Thurman, and her heirs or assigns FOREVER all the right and title in and to said LAND, heretofore held and possessed by the said STATE, and I do hereby issue this Letter Patent for the same.
