If it has already been held please state when and where held.

State Suffrage Convention was held at Dallas May 11-14th. Full data supplied to the National at the time and effort made to get a National Officer present at the Convention. Failed because of the Campaign in Iowa and the National Party Planks.

7. What plans have you made for the employment of organizers in the Autumn?

It is hoped that we can find organizers for the work and divide the state up into ten divisions, and organize very completely the thirty-one Senatorial Districts, before the meeting of the Legislature in January.

8. As a state organizer did you plan and carry out any schemes for the 4th. of July?

Nothing except presenting Suffrage Speakers at Various barbecues Civic Parades, and public Meetings as far as possible.
