Dear Sir:

As you are doubtless aware, the Fourth Liberty Loan drive will be launched September 28th, and I find myself without definite advice as to a woman chairman for _____ County.

The Government is directing that I perfect organization of the women of the state for this Loan. In the past _____ served as Chairman for this branch of war service, and I am very anxious that she continue with it; however, several communications addressed to her have met with no response. In many cases it has proved that the chairman has proceeded with organization of her county, overlooking the fact that I am not advised. This may be the case with your county.

May I ask your assistance in this matter? If unable to deliver this letter to the lady above named, will you kindly hand it to either the County Chairman of the Men's Comitty for Liberty Loan, or some prominent woman in the comunity, asking them to have a conference with others and select someone to act in this capacity and send me the name after gaining her consent to act? This will be a real service in the Liberty Loan work, and I thank you in advance for the assistance, with hope for an early response.
