I thank you for copy of your letter of June 25th to Dr. Allen Hutcheson.

I note in your No. 2 you speak of Dr. Lee's reference to "a certain 'persona non grata' individual". He refers to Nurse Bright, Superintendent. There is no foundation for Lee's complaint, as you will see from copy of Dr. J.W. Slaughter's letter to me of June 19th, which I enclose.
