his heirs or assigns FOREVER, Three hundred and twenty acres of LAND, situated and described as follows: in Houston District County

the North of Pine Creek of the Neches; by a survey of Conditional Certificate No. 50 issued by the Board of Land Commissioners of Galveston County on the 18th July 1841, upon which Conditional Certificate No. 50 was issued by the Board of Commissioners of Galveston County on the 20th March 1844
