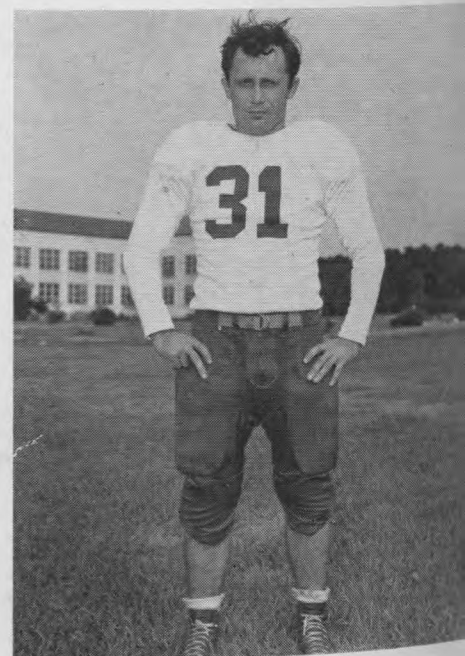

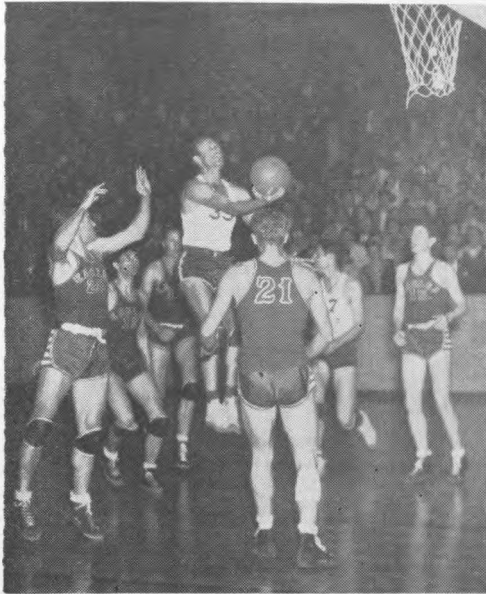

The social functions of this club included several French movies, open house, and a Christmas party. They sponsored the Hit Parade in Frontier Fiesta.

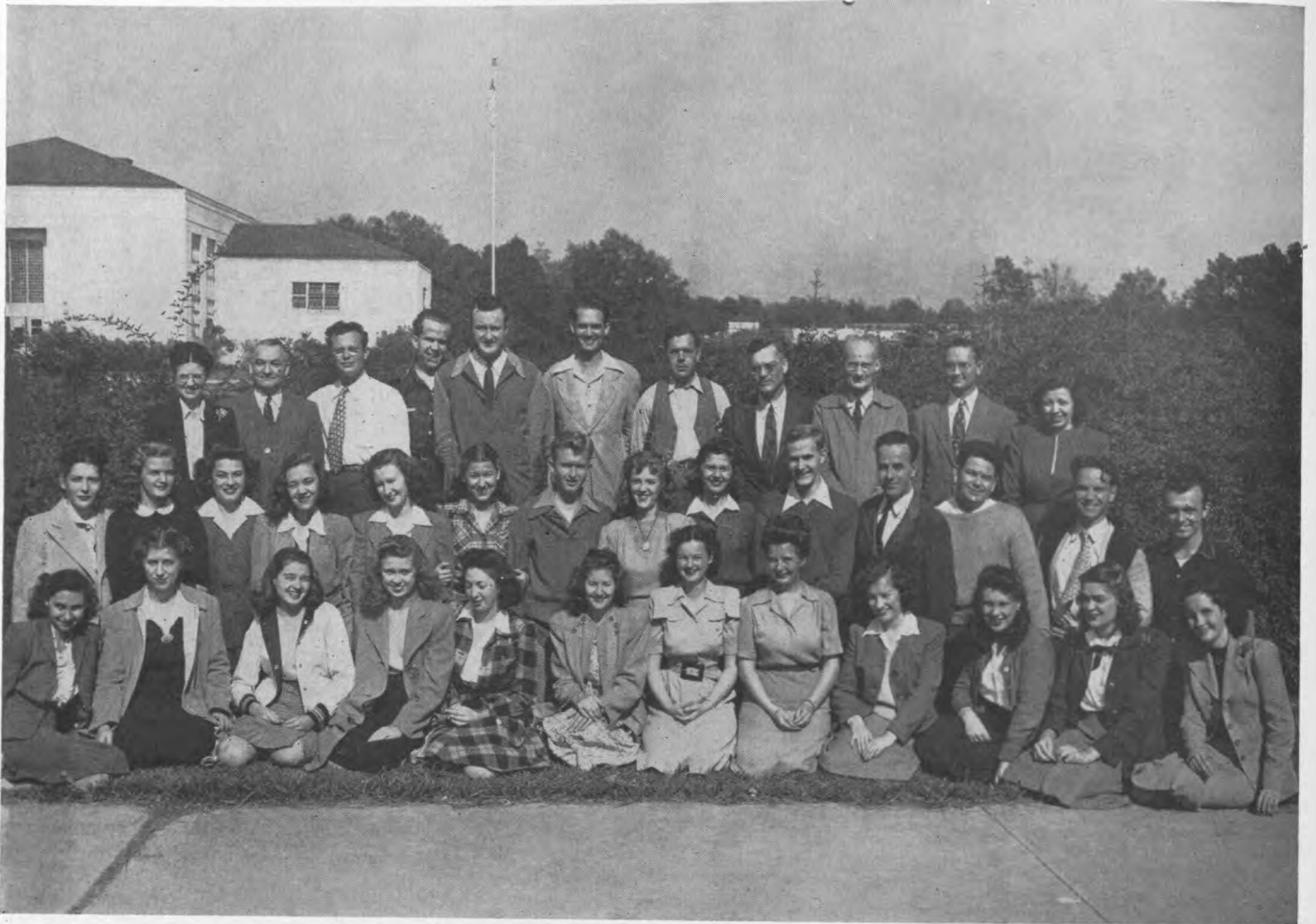
