We are enclosing samples of fliers we are getting out for statewide use and will be very glad to have reprints made for you here and sent direct from printer at the rate of \$2.00 per 1000 for the six by nine fliers, and \$2.00 per 100 for the twelve by eighteen poster. These distributed wherever and whenever they will reach the most people, will mean much in an educational way. The large posters are very effective, used about the Railroad Stations, stores, fences etc, replacing them as destroyed. The Antis have a strong line up and we must leave no stone unturned.

We are calling a meeting of all women's organizations, and all individual women interested in these two measures, with a view of getting united effort in attaining the end we seek and will you not undertake such a plan in your city and county.
