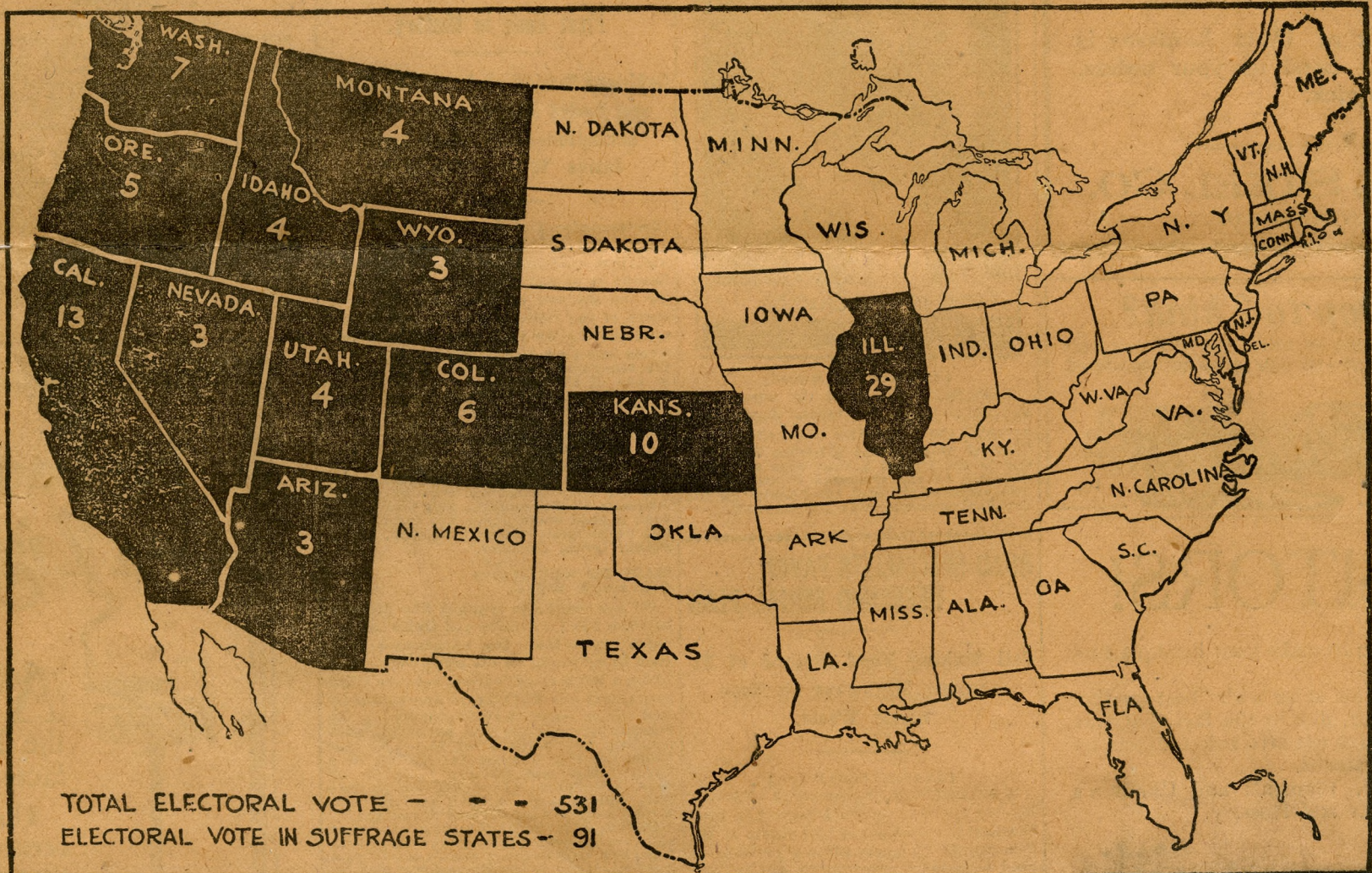

Women Hold Balance of Power for Election—if They Use It.



If women voters in the twelve suffrage States took it into their heads to vote solidly for Mr. Hughes or Mr. Wilson they could control the election. In the twelve suffrage States—shown on the map in black—where women will vote in this election there are ninety-one electoral votes. In the whole Union there are 531. The twelve suffrage States given solidly to one or the other candidate might be sufficient to swing the election.
