Also I believe we should decide how much conservation work we can do and when Fleming calls the meeting grab it. I would like us to appoint com. in all towns to provide some social life for the boys. As the most democratic organization we can do that. And we will make votes by the same. Suggest that local com.s have each church give reception & introduce boys to members & young folks. That certain groups entertain certain companies or some such scheme. I promise to work it out. Give me a state com. in that & let me outline it and then take it up with locals where camps are located. We will get every soldiers vote eventually. I have more to say but also have some sympathy for you so addios.
